Campsite Application Guidelines – Easter 2010

31st March 2010 to 7th April 2010

Dear Camper

Thank you for your enquiry regarding a campsite at the Thurra River and Mueller Inlet campgrounds during the Easter Period 2010. Please find your campsite application form, site equipment limits and Croajingolong Park notes enclosed with this letter. Please read the following information carefully as it will assist you in completing your application form.

- Applications for campsites for the Thurra River and Mueller Inlet Campgrounds for the Easter period 2010 will only be processed if they are received by mail. **Please note the application must be returned to GPO Box 359, Camberwell, Victoria 3124.**
- Applications may only be made on the campsite application form included with this letter or downloaded from the internet.
- Applications will be processed in order of receipt commencing on Monday 12th February 2010. Applications received before this date will be processed on the 12th also.
- Only one site may be applied for on each application form
- There is a three night minimum booking over this period. Shorter bookings may be considered if space permits
- A **maximum** of 6 people over the age of 3 years are permitted on any one site
- Please refer to the site equipment and vehicle limits before requesting your site preferences. Some sites are limited to one vehicle and no more than two vehicles are permitted on any campsite. If you arrive with additional vehicles that have not been included in your application, you will be charged for a full second campsite for that time.
- The 2010 camping fees are listed on the reverse of this letter. Please use this to calculate your camping fees. Payment is required in full, in advance and must be sent with your campsite application form. Payment may be made by cheque or money order. **Cheques must be made payable to KRR Services Pty Ltd.** Please note that if no payment or an incorrect payment is sent, your booking form will be returned unprocessed.
- On your application form you may specify an alternative campground, alternative campsites or alternative weeks. Please only include these if you are willing to accept them.
- Should it not be possible to allocate you a campsite that you have applied for, your payment will be fully refunded. However once a campsite is allocated there will be absolutely no refunds.
- Firewood is not included in your campsite fee but can be purchased from the campsite management, or you can bring your own. **It is illegal to collect wood from the camping area or anywhere else in the Croajingolong National Park.**
- This year there has been a large increase in the number of people requesting campsite application forms. Every effort will be made to accommodate as many campers as possible but high demand makes it likely that some applicants will not be successful.
